Florida became the first state to offer an education savings account (ESA) program for students enrolled in public schools. The program offers parents of public school students in K-5th grade access to education savings accounts, worth \$500 each, to pay for tuition and fees related to part-time tutoring, summer and after-school literacy programs, instructional materials and curriculum related to reading or literacy.

- Students must be in the K-5th grade
- Must have scored a 1 or 2 on the Third or Fourth grade English Language Arts section of the Florida Standards Assessment in the prior year or have a substantial reading deficiency in grades K-2.
- Students classified as English Language Learners receive priority
- Must remain enrolled in a public school
