



The Reading Scholarship, administered by Step Up For Students, was created to help public school students in third through fifth grade who struggle with reading. The program offers parents access to education savings accounts, worth \$500 each, to pay for tuition and fees related to part-time tutoring, **summer and after-school literacy programs**, instructional materials and curriculum related to reading or literacy.

If your summer or after-school education program is primarily focused on reading, literacy, English language usage, grammar, comprehension, vocabulary, literature and informational text or writing in English, you could qualify to provide services to a Step Up For Students Reading scholarship recipient.

Providers of summer and after-school literacy programs who meet the requirements can be pre-approved to offer services to Reading Scholarship recipients. Benefits of preapproval include giving families full confidence that they will be reimbursed by Step Up For Students for program fees and the program name and contact information will be placed on our website so Reading Scholarship recipients are able to reach out to you directly.
